- Walking distance to local transportation



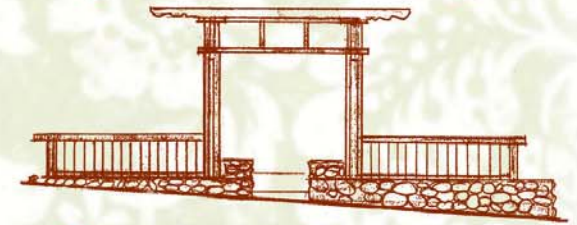
Exit Maple Street North from I-90
